## FRIENDS GIFTS

The Friends of the Library have generously funded restoration work for the sculpture *Girl Feeding Three Squirrels* by Dorothy Boehm on the east side of the Library and the cleaning and restoration of the needlework tapestry *Flora and Fauna of Illinois* in the Business Room. They have pledged funds to help with the restoration of the 28 windows in the 80 year old historic Library building. They continue to provide funds for the Children's Summer Reading programs, Teen Summer Reading and Adult Summer Reading programs, Children's programs throughout the year, three book discussion programs for adults, two book discussion groups for children and the Student Art awards. The summer reading programs for summer, 2012 will include a One Book, One Community program centered around the Civil War 150th anniversary. The book is *Manhunt: the Twelve-day Chase for Lincoln's Killer* by James L. Swanson. Called one of the best non-fiction crime books ever by Patricia Cornwell, the prolific mystery writer, *Manhunt* will appeal to a broad audience of readers. 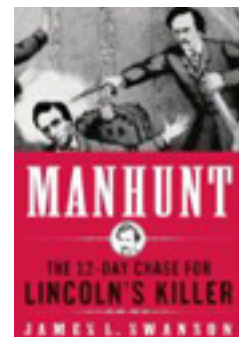

STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP 2012**

The Friends of Lake Forest Library are pleased to announce they will be awarding \$1000 senior scholarships in May of 2012 to students who clearly demonstrate a passion for reading. Graduating high school seniors who are residents of Lake Forest, Lake Bluff or Knollwood are eligible to apply for this award.

The scholarship application consists of an application form, a 500-word essay, and a recommendation from an adult. Lake Forest High School students can apply through the College Resource Center at Lake Forest High School. Scholarship applications will be available there by mid-February, and must be returned by March 16, 2012.

Eligible students at other high schools may print an application found on the Lake Forest Library Website at [www.lakeforestlibrary.org/FOLFL11.html](http://www.lakeforestlibrary.org/FOLFL11.html) as a pdf download. Copies of the application are also available at the Library.

These applications must be dropped off at the Library or be postmarked by March 16, 2012. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

In 2003, Friends of Lake Forest Library inaugurated the senior scholarship program to recognize students in whose lives reading plays an integral and enriching role. Funds for these awards come from the proceeds of the annual Book Sale held every September.
