(Lake Forest, IL) December 26, 2017 – Lake Forest Library is hosting a free Google Expeditions AR (Augmented Reality) event on Thursday, December 28, 2017. During two sessions—from 10 a.m. to Noon, and 1 to 3 p.m.—library visitors can view 3D virtual models using the latest in Google technology.

30-minute tours throughout the two sessions will include a range of subjects. Get a new view on dinosaur extinction while seeing a Stegosaurus or Tyrannosaurus Rex up close. Learn about the Space Race as you study Sputnik and the Telstar Communications Satellite from all angles. Transverse the centuries by examining ancient coins, jewelry, and farming implements from Roman times. Other subjects for the day include Forces of Nature, the Ocean Floor, and World War II Warfare.

Google Expeditions AR is pushing the boundaries of education, mixing the real world with the virtual by bringing 3D objects to life. According to Google, augmented reality events like the one at Lake Forest Library are a great opportunity to "use our devices to get up close to see detail, or step back to get a sense of scale and point out new discoveries."
