


How to Use the Projector



DO NOT: Store or use the projector in an extremely hot area ... Disassemble or modify the projector ... Block the vents on the side or top of the projector.




- Charge your projector with the AC power adapter until the Charging indicator lights change from red to green.
- Connect the Projector to your device (computer or tablet) using the HDMI cord. If your device does not have an HDMI port, you will need an HDMI adapter (not included).




- 3. Place the **Projector** on a hard, flat, and steady surface. Slide the **OFF/ON** switch to turn it on.
- 4. Aim the lens at a screen or blank wall, then turn the Focus dial to bring the picture into focus.
- 5. Press VOL+ or VOL- to adjust the Projector's volume level. Make sure that your device's volume is set to at least 50%. You can also connect headphones or speakers with a 3.5 mm audio cable (not included) into the headphone jack on the left side of the Projector.
- **6.** When you are done using the projector, slide the **OFF/ON** switch to OFF.

How to Use the Screen



#	ITEM	DESCRIPTION
1	Screen hanger notch	Provides a notch to hang the projector screen.
2	Flip-lever center column lock	Locks or unlocks the first section of the tripod center column.
3	Screen height handle	Hold this handle to raise or lower the center column.
4	Flip-lever for the screen height handle lock	Locks or unlocks to slide up or down the screen height handle.
5	Positioning pin release lever	Push this release lever to insert or release the positioning pin in the positioning hole.
6	Positioning hole	Attaches to the positioning pin on the back of the projector screen.
7	Tripod leg	Supports the tripod and projector screen.
8	Screen enclosure	Enclosure for the screen when not in use.
9	Projector screen hanging bracket	Hang the projector screen using this bracket.
10	Positioning pin	Position projector screen by inserting it into positioning hole.
11	Projector screen	Displays pictures from the projector.



- Open the three legs of the tripod and stand the tripod up.
- 2. Loosen the Flip-lever center column lock, then raise the center column so that the Screen hanger notch is just below your eye-level, then fasten the Flip-lever center column lock to secure the column in place.




3. Unlock the Flip-lever for the screen height handle lock and slide the Screen height handle to your waist level, then fasten the Flip-lever for the screen height handle to secure it in place.

How to Use the Screen continued...

4. While holding the Screen enclosure, push the red Positioning pin release lever and insert the Positioning pin into the Positioning hole. When the pin is fully inserted, the Positioning pin release lever will spring back into its non-released position.



5. Pull out the Projector screen by pulling up on the Projector screen hanging bracket, then hang the Projector screen hanging bracket on the Screen hanger notch on top of the center column.



- 6. From the back side of the screen, you can now set the height of the screen. You can set the height of the bottom edge of the screen by unlocking the Flip-lever for the screen height handle and changing the position of the screen height handle. Change the height of the top edge of the screen by unlocking the Flip-lever center column lock, and raising the center column.
- 7. To take down screen, reverse the setup steps.
